Nine of us Canadians arrived to Outreach Feb. 7, and a couple came on Monday, making the Canadian team 11. Monday (Feb. 8) Frank and Emil worked on a tractor at Spanish American Evangelistic Ministries which had them befuddled on previous attempts to repair it. They finally got it running and were praising the Lord. I worked indoors doing some sorting chores. On Tuesday we ordered and picked up material for constructing a house, and did some digging to put in the outdoor plumbing pipes. Wednesday some Mennonites from Jagueyes Colony came to help us build. We had three long days, but on Saturday worked only till noon, began mudding, installed doors and began finishing trim work. Meanwhile the ladies cooked, ordered some groceries which we men picked up at Soriano one evening, enough to fill 200 grocery bags, about \$1,500 worth Canadian; some of the ladies did some painting. Saturday afternoon we had lunch at International Market, drove up a mountain to an observation place overlooking Juarez, and some of El Paso. We distributed about 75 grocery bags and later went to Peter Pipers for Supper. All of these fun activities included passing out Gospel Tracts and New Testaments to various people. Monday (Feb. 15) we plan to begin inside construction at Pastor Ruben's church; and a few from Jagueyes are expected to help get us started. God Bless to all.
