Just hours later they received word that their application, along with 2 others in what is hoped to be a group of a dozen or more stations, was approved. Now the work begins in earnest to bring these small community stations on air with as much Low German programming as possible. Please pray in praise for this outreach opportunity, and pray for wisdom, endurance and unity for the groups and individuals who will be hard at work making the plans of the last months and years come to reality. 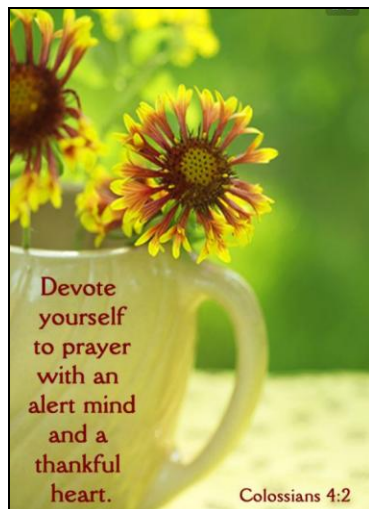
