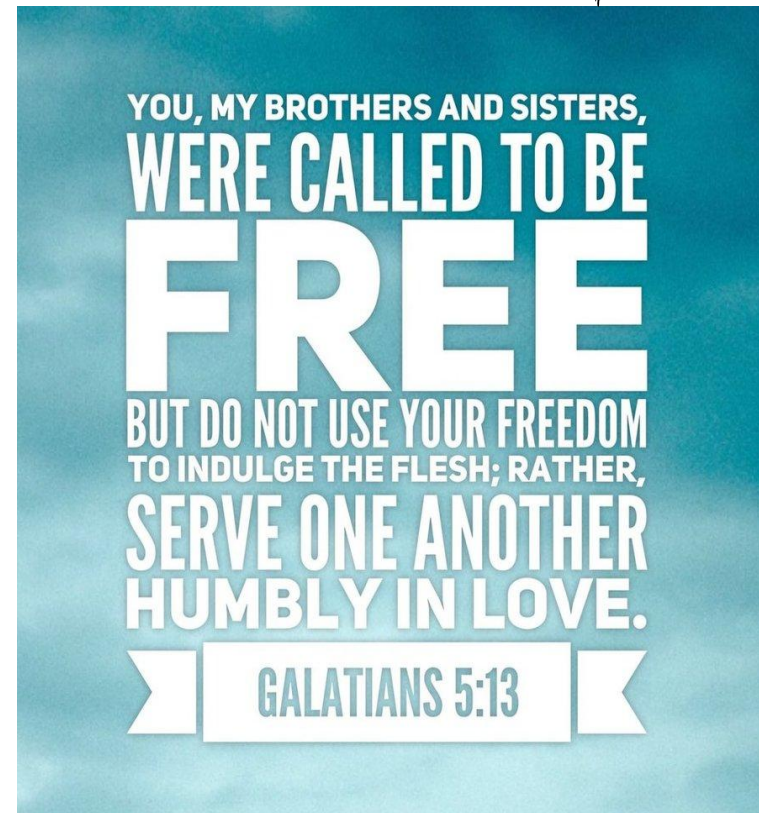


## **PRAYER FOCUS - FEBRUARY 4, 2018**

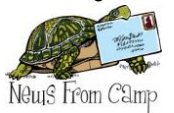
