

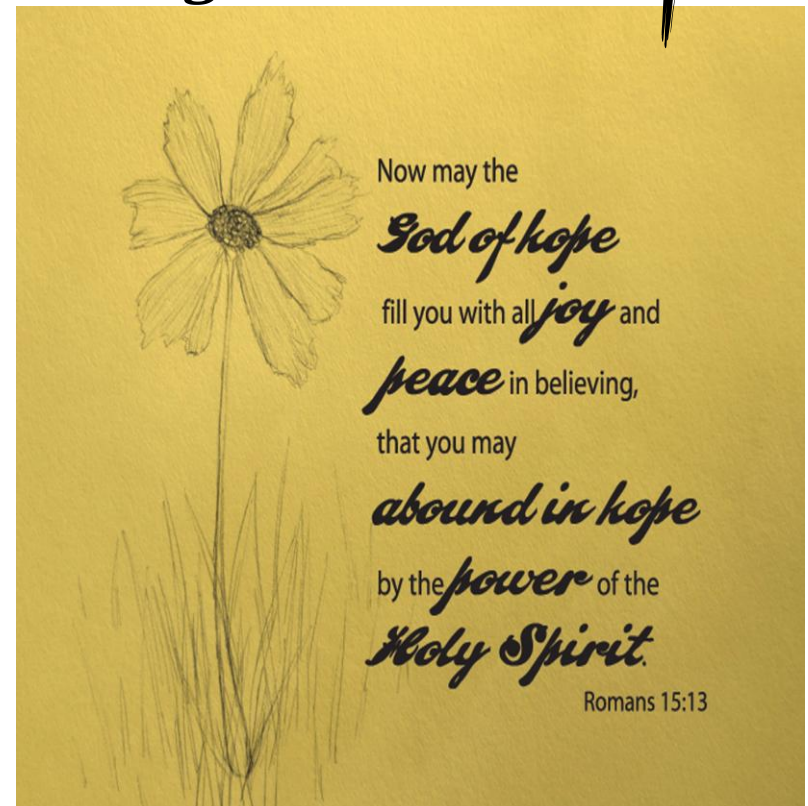

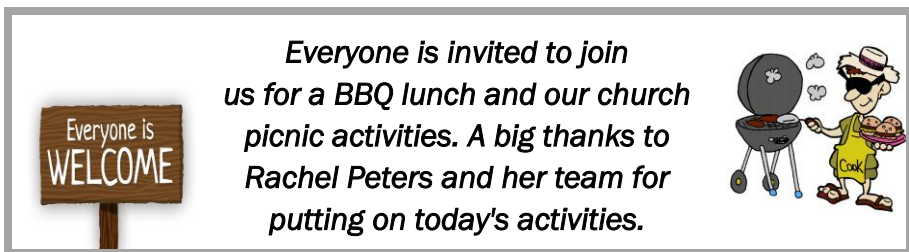

Financial Update:

Approved 2018 Budget = 262,019.00 = 5,038.83/wk (x 21 as of May 27) = 105,815.43 = amount required to meet our budget.

Our income as of May 27 = 98,347.11 = a budget shortfall of 7,468.32

Defibrillator Update : Our Goal = 1,600.00

Received to date = 1,230.00 = shortfall 370.00 (you may still designate towards this project, mark envelope 'Defib' or 'AED' and amt.)
