



PRAYER FOCUS - MAY 26, 2019

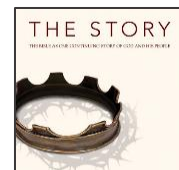
