Missionaries:** Pray for Ken & Bertha Guenther, serving with SEND International: “10 weeks in Russia: From April 1 - June 7, we joined a new team in Russia focused on reaching two unreached Muslim people groups. We were surprised at the openness of people in general to the Gospel, while at the same time recognizing that few of those who considered themselves Muslim were practicing Muslims. Our primary purpose in spending time with this team was to encourage and support the team during this year that their team leader is back in the States. During these weeks, we sought to encourage younger team members in their spiritual life, help the team identify some challenges they need to face, guide them in working through some interpersonal difficulties and coach them in thinking about future ministry opportunities. Pray with us for: Our upcoming International Leadership Team meetings. Pray for clearer vision, stronger relationships, and sharper understanding of how we need to change in the way that we lead; Our big summer training in August for 19 new missionaries and their 14 children. Ken will be teaching, and Bertha will be working with the children (not cooking!); Our new friends in Russia who were in weekly Bible studies but have not yet given their lives to Jesus; Pray for wisdom in preparing training for the team in Russia.
