

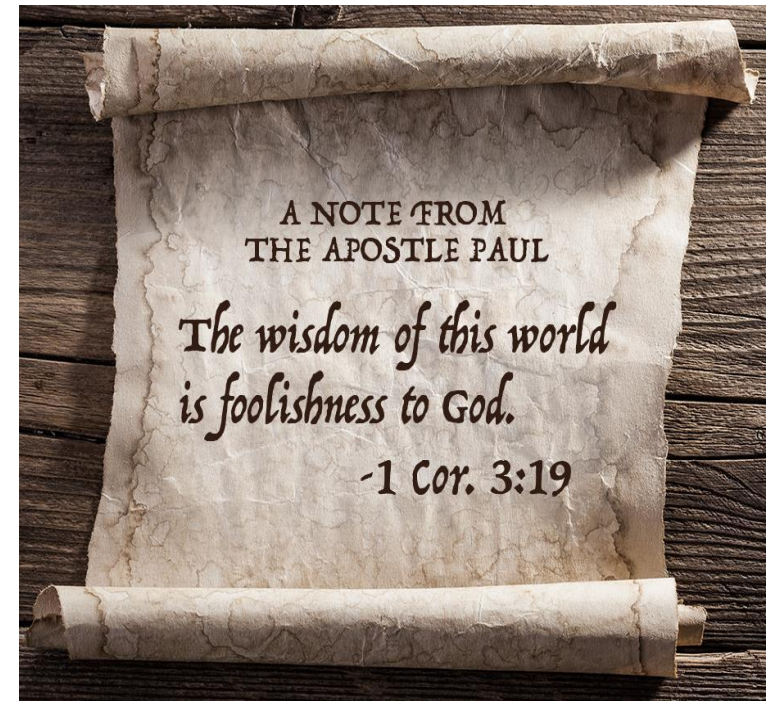
## PRAYER FOCUS – SEPTEMBER 1, 2019
