We poured our cement pad for the car port and await the men from Seminole to come next week to construct our car port structure.

A son of one of our elderly church couples passed away early this morning and our outreach centre became a gathering place for the women from the community who came to comfort the mother of the deceased. Pastor Joel was very busy today consoling people, making funeral arrangements, etc. There are some new families getting involved in Joel and Amber's Church, and this is encouraging to them, and to us as we have gotten to know them better.”
