**Kadesh News:** “Hello Churches, it is with great sadness that we announce that Camp Kadesh will not run in the summer of 2020. On June 5<sup>th</sup> the SK government changed the language of Phase 4 of the Reopen SK plan to only mention ‘day’ camps. For the first time since the beginning of overnight camp programming with Mid Prairie Scripture Mission there will be no chance to present the gospel through summer camp. We want everyone to know that we did our best for a safe alternative but in the end the decision was not ours. The cancellation for our Spring/Summer programs is a significant financial hit to Camp Kadesh as a non-profit organization. The money already invested into planning for this summer can only be offset by donations at this point. We will need the support of our community to retain our full-time team, maintain facilities, and work to be ready for reopening. Thank you for praying. We don’t know how God will use this, but we believe He will.”
