

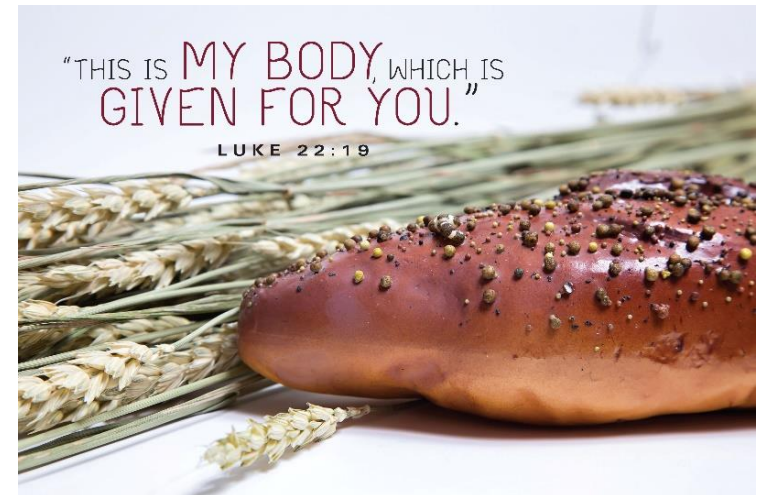
PRAYER FOCUS – FEBRUARY 21, 2021

- Missionary Focus:** Pray for Eugene Enns, General Director of Grace Mission: “Having good leaders determines the success now and the future of any missionary venture. We depend greatly on leaders in the fields of Haiti & Mexico to lead the ministry. In Haiti we have made a concerted effort over the past years to begin training and thinking in such a way with this question: *What if there were no more North American leaders able to come to Haiti to help oversee the work?* Our challenge to the Haitian leaders has been to consider that possibility and step up to the challenge of taking total care of the ministry. They know that when missionaries leave a ministry and return to North America, the ministry structure crumbles and leaders begin to change the direction and outcomes of actual spiritual ministry and accomplishment. Right now, due to COVID, the rules have changed for reentering the U.S.A. You must show a valid COVID test with negative results, taken within 3 days of departure. Without adequate testing in Haiti there is no way to return. For now, this is an obstacle that may be overcome but what about the future. As the world changes, we must be ready for any event that will certainly change missions. Our best answer is to simply continue to do what the Bible says: Disciple / train leaders deal with their own people and ministry challenges and do their best to take care of mission property with help from a distance. Please pray for our mission leaders.”

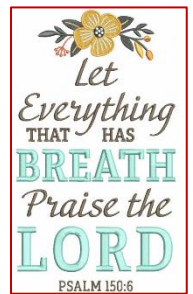
