- 1. Missionary Focus: Pray for Joel and Amber Cera, serving with Christlike Ministries in Mexico: "Recent ministry opportunities have opened up for Pastor Joel and the Villa Esperanza Church. Immigrants from such places as Haiti and Cuba have been arriving in and around Ciudad Juarez, (Juarez City) with hopes that they will be permitted to enter the USA, due to recent changes in the presidency. Immigrants have been settling in along the border crossing between Juarez and El Paso, Texas. Joel has been to minister to these immigrants along the border who have congregated on the Mexican side, with food, drink and gospel literature. He has also become aware of a community of immigrants who have settled in the Anapra neighborhood in northern Juarez, the part of the city closest to the border crossing. This community of around 300 people have really appreciated pastor Joel's visits with food, drinks, gospel literature, etc. Since Christlike's designated drug rehab center property (situated about ten blocks from our Outreach Center) has not taken root, Joel envisions using the property to house displaced immigrants. Recently a family from Haiti was housed on the Outreach Center for several days, in a spare room in the duplex. The three-times-weekly food distribution from the rehab property continues into the neighbourhood. The Villa Esperanza Church continues to thrive. Joel and Amber thank SEC for continued support of their ministry."


