a) Pray for Assist Canada Cuban Ministries (Jacob Rempel): “I am requesting prayer for our SEA CONTAINER of rice that was shipped some weeks ago. This is urgently needed & yet sits on the dock. One of our Cuba representatives is currently in Cuba & reported this today: The Sea Can is having significant delays and other issues because of how the paperwork was completed. We need much prayer over this to prevent the rice from being locked away to rot. Josue the convention president has travelled to Havana a few times already to try and deal with this in person but no success thus far. We are asking for prayer that this may be released with no strings attached as to distribution. Thank you very much. Blessings from the sea, Jacob – ASSIST Canada-Cuba Ministries.”

b) Pray for Marsden and Mandy Giesbrecht, serving in northern Saskatchewan with Healing Hearts Ministries: “Over the past months there have been significant leadership changes in HHMI. A new director has been hired and most long-term board members have come to the end of their terms. Many staff members have moved on and only a few missionaries remain. Though change may feel uncertain, there is no uncertainty in God. He remains faithful. We hope to continue in the work God has called us to here in Nipawin and are unsure about any of the many details surrounding the process.
