The main purpose of this mission was to train pastors for our Motorcycle Evangelists Program (MEP), from 5 different countries, and to transport Jesus Film backpacks to Rwanda and DR Congo. We had an evangelistic crusade planned in a small village about 35 minutes from Chongwe. The church in this village had been struggling with poor attendance and many people being drawn into the local cults. We showed the Jesus film and after I presented the Gospel message – 70 people came forward to accept Christ as their personal Saviour! We are hoping/planning on expanding our MEP in 2022. We would like to add 30 Jesus Film Backpacks and 32 motorcycles in the countries that we now serve. This would mean that by the end of 2022 – Beautiful Feet Ministry Motorcycle Evangelists would be doing over 6,240 crusades per year! Only God knows how many souls will be added to His Kingdom with this initiative! Please pray for this program and these workers!"
