"Bertha and I had planned to return to North America on Feb 20 to put ourselves in the right time zone for leading our online Member Orientation Program. Due to the possibility of armed conflict between Russia & Ukraine, the uncertainty



of what was going to happen in Ukraine and how this might disrupt travel and Internet communications, we decided to leave Ukraine three weeks early. After a week in the USA (spent with our International Office staff who work out of that location), we flew to Canada, and are now back in Sask. Most of our SEND workers in Ukraine have remained in the country, although they are carefully monitoring the situation and have evacuation plans in place. We ask for your prayers for a peaceful resolution of the tension. Our biggest concern is that this conflict between these two large countries could potentially hinder the possibility of Ukrainian missionaries going to the unreached peoples in Russia and other parts of Eurasia. Please pray: a) For a peaceful resolution to the political tension between Russia and the West; b) That whatever happens, the opportunity for Ukrainians to go as missionaries to the unreached in Russia and other countries would not be hampered; c) For the protection & peace of mind of the missionaries still in Ukraine; d) For wisdom for those missionaries who have left Ukraine. When should we return to our homes & ministries?"
