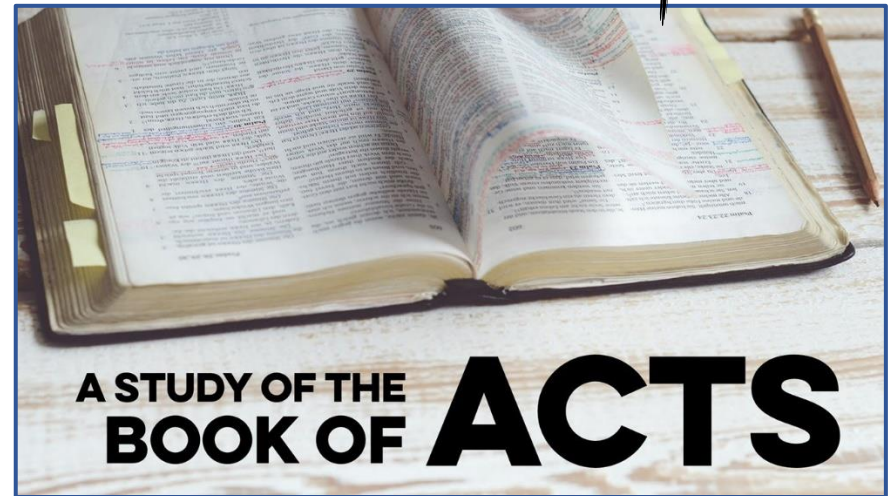


# PRAYER FOCUS – MARCH 20, 2022

The news is full of fear and uncertainty. The confidence that we can have in knowing our saviour, Jesus Christ rises above this fear. He has promised to never leave or forsake us. This earthly journey is brief but life with Him is eternal. This hope is for all who believe, repent and accept the Good News. This is the message that each of you have enabled Beautiful Feet Ministry to share in 5 countries: Zambia, Malawi, Mozambique, Rwanda, and DR Congo and in Syria. Together we are training and equipping evangelists, in each of these countries, to share the gospel with their own people in their own language. These evangelists are becoming those Beautiful Feet that bring hope. On March 2<sup>nd</sup> we loaded 40 skids of all the books and all the donated resources into a container at Shercom and everything fit perfectly! The container is currently on its way to Montreal for loading on the ship to be sent to Zambia. Our motorcycle evangelist program suffered a major loss last month as one of the evangelists from Malawi was killed in a motorcycle accident after returning from conducting a crusade.
