

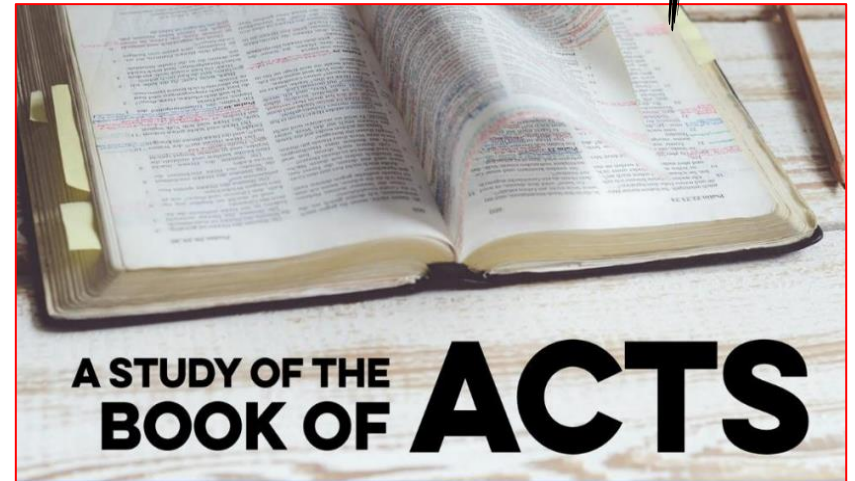
PRAYER FOCUS — APRIL 24, 2022

1. **Missionary Focus:** Pray for Wes & Carol Schellenberg, serving with Avant Ministries in Winnipeg: “At the end of October, my (Wes) workload increased unexpectedly. The person who looked after payroll and benefits for our Canadian missionaries needed to go on leave and planned to return after 5 months. I supervise and review this work as part of my regular duties, so I was familiar with the concepts and policies. However, the start-to-finish steps were something I needed to learn. This took place during what is Avant’s busiest accounting season: fiscal year end, followed by the financial audit. I frequently felt overwhelmed, yet the Lord provided understanding that was not my own! As missionaries and churches in Europe have continued to help refugees that are pouring in, Avant Ministries has established the Ukraine Crisis Response project to assist these churches, who often are barely able to provide for their own needs, to be able to help refugees and war victims. Avant sent out letters and highlighted the project on its website, and funds began to come in. I process donations at the Canada office, so I have a front row seat to watch donors in Canada respond. Thank you for enabling us to do the work God has called us to.” – Wes & Carol

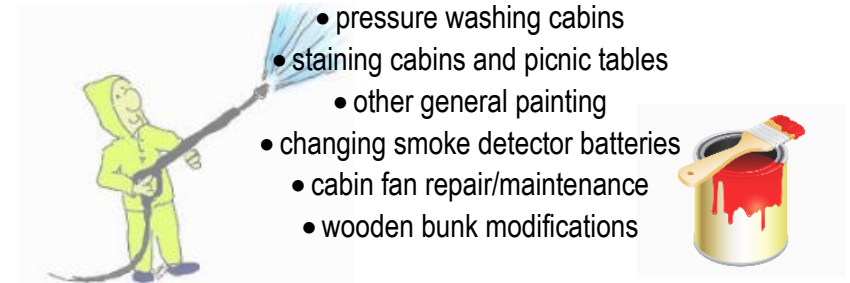
Saturday, May 28th
