1. Missionary Focus: Pray for Ken & Bertha Guenther, serving with SEND International in Kyiv (now in Canada): "We left Ukraine on January 30th, prior to the start of the conflict. Reports we hear from those who fled the bombing or stayed behind are truly horrific. Interestingly many of the refugees are evangelical believers and are going to European countries that have significantly fewer evangelical believers than Ukraine. Could God use this crisis to plant gospel churches in Europe by means of Ukrainian refugees? SEND has responded to over 200 requests for help and distributed close to \$600,000. Most of it going to help churches that are providing shelter, food, and other assistance to those who have been displaced. For now, we will be staying in Canada, at least until July when we go to Michigan to run another Member Orientation Program. SEND will not allow us to return to Ukraine as long as it

is in danger of bombing. My (Ken) workload has remained about the same but less convenient dealing with the time zone issues. We are looking for other possible ministry bases around the world. We would welcome your prayers about future decisions. We are also praying for peace in Ukraine so that we can return home."
