2-week Member Orientation Program for new missionaries. From our rental home in Hague, SK, I can lead both the SEND training team and the International Services team. Please pray for peace in Ukraine; for direction and patience for the new missionaries who were headed to Russia and Ukraine but cannot go there now. Thank you so much for your prayers and financial support."

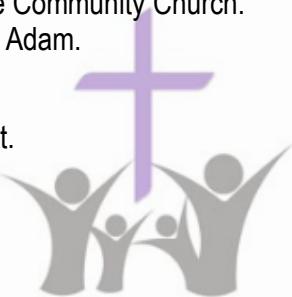
