Wilson, from Haiti, and Jorge, from Mexico, are a great help in our projects. Wilson is fluent in English. Projects: Some plumbing work needed, some vehicle repair. Clothing store will be moved downstairs. I painted the room and Dirkson is laying tile. We also rented a backhoe to dig a big hole for our septic project. We have a plan for gravity and seepage material and no pump is necessary. We had to throw many rocks and cinder block material into the pit by hand. On Sunday I went to both worship services, 9am and noon. Tomorrow some of our team including me will be going to Cuauhtemoc with the Cera family. Thursday and Friday will be a missionary conference in Joel's home church. On Saturday we plan to travel into the mountains to minister the gospel and to bring 50 shoebox gifts to donate to the Tarahumara Indian children. Dirk and Linda are fitting in well. God bless and thank you for your prayer support. I love you all."


