I have a reminder on my phone that reminds me several times a day to pray for Ukraine. That concern has only intensified in the last few days. In the last month, two SEND couples have returned to Kyiv to live and a couple more returned briefly to pack up their stuff so that it could be moved to their new location. But in the last three weeks there have also been multiple strikes on Kyiv and other Ukrainian cities using drones and missiles to attack the energy infrastructure of the country. This week, 80% of the residents of Kyiv were without water and many were without electricity for a while. Prayer requests: (a) Peace in Ukraine - an end to the military conflict and the destruction and death; (b) Heat and electricity for our friends and co-workers in Kyiv as winter approaches; (c) Mentors for each SEND worker who would like to be mentored; (d) Vision, faith and discernment as the training team and other service departments put together their 2023 ministry plans; (d) Grace and strength to manage all the administrative tasks of Ken's role while also caring for our missionaries in far-away places and our family here at home.
