





Advent - Week Three - JOY

Day One – Jesus is the Great High Priest – Hebrews 4:14

What a privilege to have direct access to God! Understanding the Old Testament offering sacrifices helps us to rejoice in the finished work of Jesus. Approach the throne of grace confidently and pour out your heart to God. You will not be turned away.

Day Two – Jesus is the Alpha and Omega – Revelation 1:8

Faith is "confidence in what we hope for and assurance about what we do not see" (Heb. 11:1), trusting God's character regardless of what life's circumstances look like. In what areas of your life do you need to trust God? Surrender it to Him today.

Day Three - Jesus is the True Vine - John 15:1, 5a

Recognizing our destructive bent toward self-reliance, Jesus urges His followers to "remain in Me" five times in only eight verses. Today, read John 15:1-8 and reflect on the invitation to savor a close connection to the True Vine. Are you as close as He invites you to be? Take a few moments to rest before God.

Day Four - Jesus is the Prince of Peace - Isaiah 9:6-7a

Family get-togethers can be filled with tension as jealousy and old wounds often shatter Christmas peace. Think ahead to your social commitments and write down names who cause unrest in your heart. Spend time with Jesus, asking for His direction, committing yourself to being His ambassador of peace.

Day Five – Jesus is the Bread of Life – John 6:35

Many people try to fill the void in their lives with more stuff (money, friends, food, shopping), but they are left wanting. Examine your heart and desires. Do you crave stuff, or do you crave Jesus?

Some activity suggestions for this third week of Advent:

- 1. Go caroling in your neighbourhood to bring the joy of Jesus.
- 2. Make snow angels and reflect on the role of angels in the nativity story.
- 3. Ask grandparents what Christmas was like when they were kids.
- 4. Watch a movie about the nativity of Jesus.
- 5. Take cookies to your children's ministry leader or Sunday School teacher.
- 6. Cheer when you drive by nativity displays.
