Advent – Week Four - LOVE

Day One - Jesus is the Good Shepherd - John 10:11

Through whatever you are facing, you are not alone. The Good Shepherd does not leave your side. As you go about your day, talk to Jesus and tell Him what you're facing. He knows and cares for you. He will protect you with His own life.

Day Two – Jesus is Immanuel (God with us) – Matthew 1:23

Spend time in God's presence, worshipping Him. Set aside the shopping, baking, holiday frenzy and take a few moments just to be with Him. He longs for you and waits for you. Immanuel.

Day Three – Jesus is the Son of Man – Mark 10:45

Jesus humbled Himself to wash His disciples' feet. Read John 13:3-17. Jesus' example calls us to bow low in humble service. Who is God calling you to serve today? Imitate Him and use your spiritual gifts to serve others as you would serve Christ Himself.

Day Four – Jesus was a Man of Sorrows – Isaiah 53:3

For many, the Christmas season brings disappointment, loss, heartache, regret, and pain. Instead of ignoring this pain, allow it to surface and then bring it to the feet of Jesus. Reflect on the suffering that Jesus faced, and then spend the day worshipping Him, who was a Man of Sorrows, but is now exalted at God's right hand.

Day Five - Jesus is the Lamb of God - John1:29

Have you lost the wonder and awe of Jesus' sacrifice for you sins? Today, worship Jesus for His sacrificial atonement, for taking His sins on Himself.
