

# <u>Advent – Week One - HOPE</u>

### Day One - Jesus - Matthew 1:21

As you enter this season of Advent, what expectations do you have of Jesus? Regardless of how He answers your prayers, ask Him to show you what He wants to do in your life. Begin this Advent season with an open heart.



### Day Two - Resurrection and the Life - John 11:25

Jesus nullified death's hold on His creation when He willingly laid down His own life and defeated death. Those who believe in Him have also been raised to new life with Him. Jesus' resurrection gives us hope both for today and for the future.

### Day Three – King of Kings – Matthew 2:2

The whole universe worships the King of kings—but as humans we often miss out on this privilege. We focus on ourselves and become prideful, angry, and annoyed with others, especially during this busy holiday season. Today, take your eyes off yourself and fix your gaze on the King of Glory.

### Day Four - Light of the World - John1:9

Christmastime is filled with lights. On trees, on houses, on signs. It is easy to let these lights drown out the shining light within us. Ask God to shine in you to help you see God in your surroundings, and through you so that others may see the hope that you have.

# Day Five - Christ (Messiah) - Matthew 2:4

Reacquaint yourself with Jesus through the gospels. Chuckle at His wit; weep as He is rejected; rejoice as the stone is rolled away.

- 1. Decorate the Christmas tree together, reflecting on the beautiful meaning of this season of celebrating.
