More than 100 wildfires this early in the season is unusual and devastating to many people. Over 20,000 people have been evacuated from their homes, towns, and reserves. Many of these people, having no place to go, have been relocated to hotels, in and near Edmonton. I was able to connect with a few displaced First Nations Peoples and hear their stories. I was able to share in their sorrow, in their grief, in their uncertainty, and in their hope; and in some cases, I was able to share with them the hope of more than a home here in Canada, but an everlasting home with the Great Creator. The God above all gods. The God of hope, mercy, of peace, and love.

Cuba continues to experience great shortages in resources. There is no reprieve in sight. Continue to pray for Medical and Humanitarian Aid to be allowed past the blockade. The Cuban church continues to flourish amidst these difficult times. Pray for much needed resources and funds to continue to enter Cuba and to be properly distributed. Pray for foreigners such as us to continue to generously donate to the needs of Cuba. – Jake Rempel"


