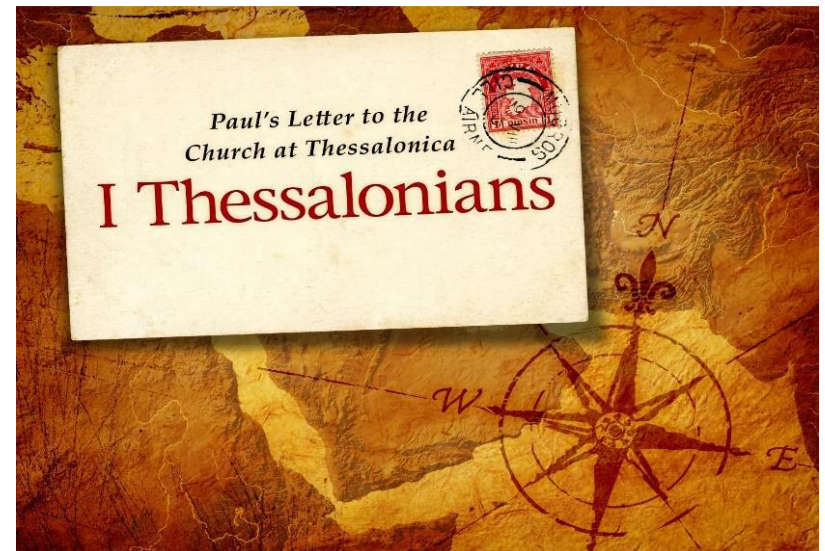
A Prayer for Hope
