

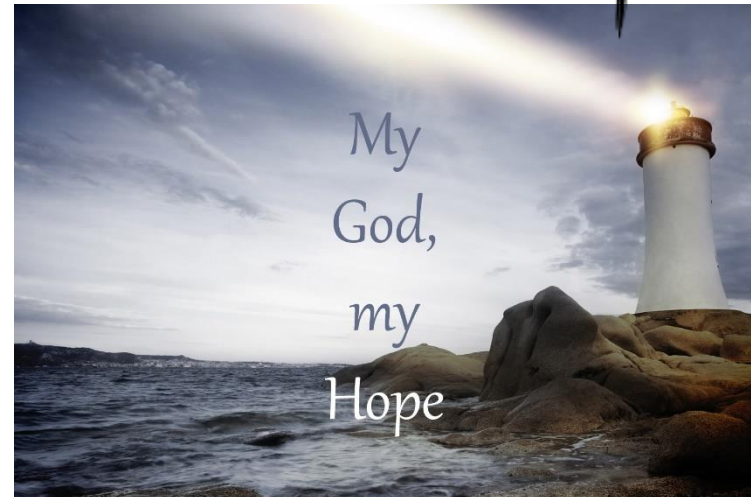
PRAYER FOCUS – OCTOBER 22, 2023

- 1. Missionary Focus:** From Wayne Senger, serving short-term with Christlike Ministries: “Hi friends in Christ. Recently I helped to spread pecan shells over the ground after completing our sewer project, I have learned to repair window screens and we have done maintenance on some vehicles. Tomorrow, we plan to go to a large drug rehab center to which we have not previously been. We will make about 200 burritos in the morning, each resident of rehab center will receive 2 burritos. We may put on a drama about Saul putting Christians in prison after which he will be struck blind on the road to Damascus and became Paul; as well as preaching the gospel and some music. Friday we’ll pick our vehicle in El Paso. The rebuilt transmission will cost the ministry about \$2,000. I will deliver the sermon at the Church which Pastor Aurelio (recently passed away) helped to begin some years ago. A week from Friday we are looking forward to participating with Pastor Javier who runs a smaller drug rehab center and who also has been going to downtown Juarez every Friday to present the gospel and provide food for the downtown poor people and many migrants. We are experiencing much grace here, no doubt in large part because of your prayers for us, God Bless.”

Many of our staff are separated from their families and don’t even know if all their loved ones are safe yet. Missions teams are stuck and unable to get into or out of Israel safely right now. Please stand with us today. Please pray for Israel, for those suffering, for our missionaries, and for Jewish Israelis who don’t yet know Yeshua as their personal Saviour.”
