International Day of Prayer for the Persecuted Church

India

- Most populous country.
- The rural population is mostly impoverished.
- Approx. 69 million Christians
- RSS (an Indian right-wing Hindu organization) informants live in nearly every village and report on the activities of Christians, resulting in attacks and arrests.
- Churches demolished, Bibles burned, pastors beaten and jailed.

Nigeria

- Africa's most populous nation
- Muslims in the north and Christians in the south
- Islam terrorist group, Boko Haram, has significantly slowed missionary activity.
- Because of the violence, nearly all Christians in northeastern Nigeria have lost family members. Life is a constant struggle for Christians, and, in some places, it is difficult to find food.

Nicaragua

- Estimates suggest that 95% Christian.
- In 2018 the church provided shelter and care for people during protests against the government, which has resulted in the government persecuting Christians to this day.
- Church leaders are arrested, and churches are prevented from meeting publicly. Clergy members, pastors, missionaries, parishioners, and entire congregations live in fear of harassment and persecution.
- "We believe prayer has helped us endure this persecution." -Pastor Dario
