

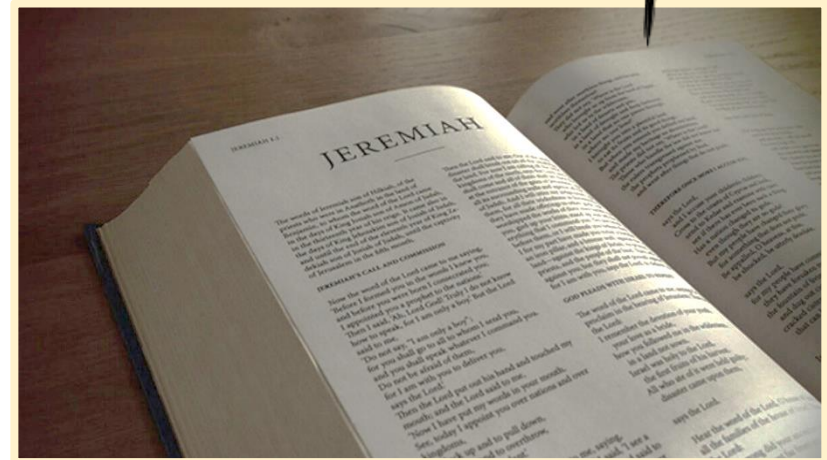
## PRAYER FOCUS – FEBRUARY 4, 2024

As EC Secretary I am already involved in planning the agenda for the Branch Conference. On the 22<sup>nd</sup>, we will go to Cairns to have Carl's eyes checked and for a vacation. We have not made specific plans for the latter half of the year, but we anticipate putting our Ukarumpa house on the market in the hope that it will sell before we return to settle in Canada in 2025. The Menya people are continuing in their commitment to translating the Old Testament and seeing God's Word in Menya is having a great effect on their lives. We are anticipating that I will continue in service part time with WBTC and SIL-PNG from Canada, to continue helping with the exegetical check of the Old Testament, to help maintain accuracy and naturalness. Thank you for your interest, prayers and financial support of us and God's work in PNG."
