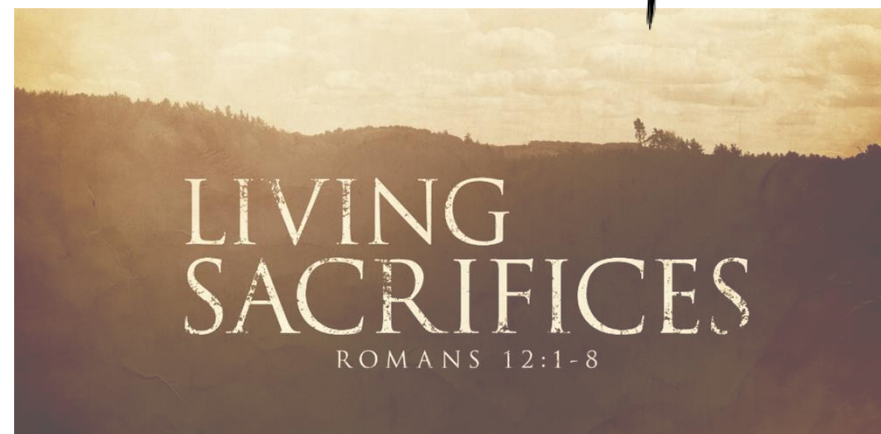
PRAYER FOCUS – MAY 5, 2024
