  - Thank you for praying for Lil Goertzen. She is back to work in the EMMC office!

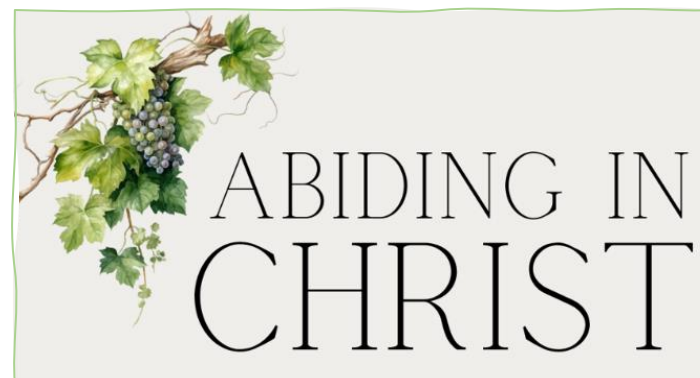

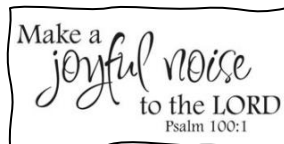
