

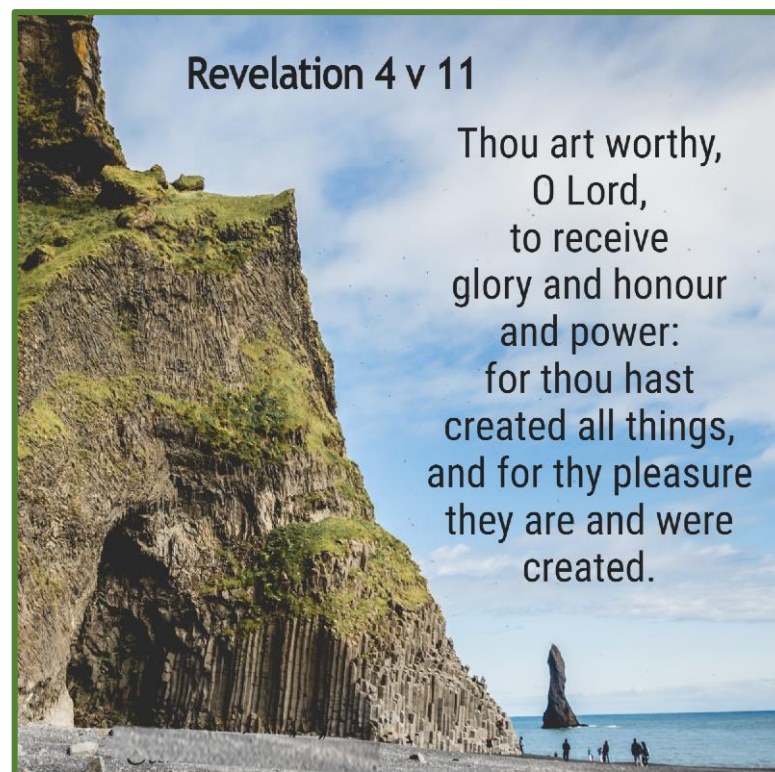
PRAYER FOCUS – SEPTEMBER 22, 2024

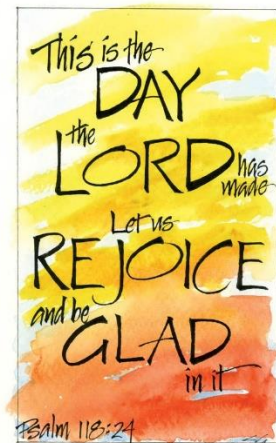
