

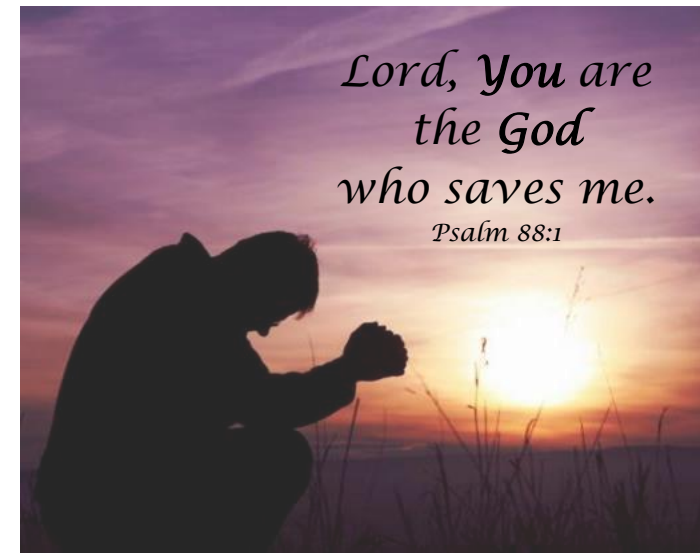
PRAYER FOCUS – JULY 13, 2025
