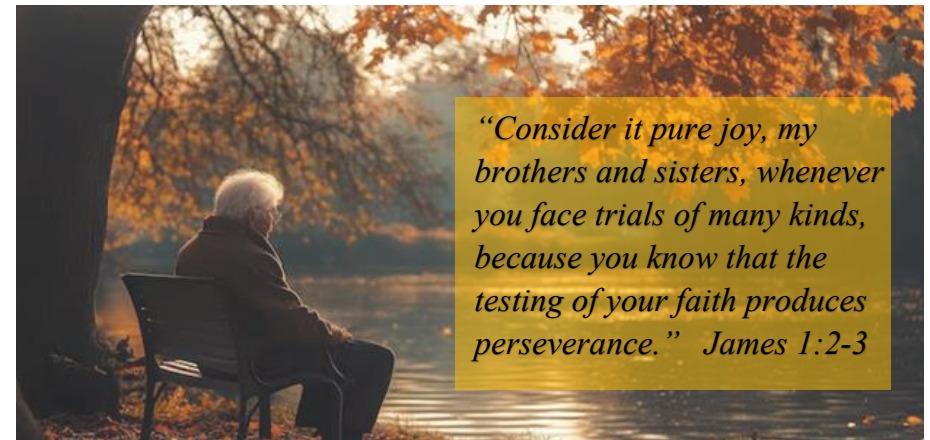


## PRAYER FOCUS – SEPTEMBER 21, 2025
